- TSL401 Teaching and Learning Languages For the first half, students learn teaching specific language skills, classroom management, planning lessons, designing tests, evaluating textbooks, and developing skills as a teacher. In the second half, students have opportunities to observe experienced ESL teachers and analyze their teaching methods. Students also develop lesson plans and teach a few ESL lessons that will be evaluated.
- TSL402 Second Language Acquisition This course offers a theoretical and experimental field of study which looks at how non-native language ability develops, stabilizes, and undergoes attrition.
- TSL403 Introduction to Linguistics This course introduces the terminology and methodology of modern linguistic science. The topics include (but are not limited to) structure of language, dialects, language disorders, and animal communication. This course also addresses some common misconceptions about language.
- TSL404 Structure of English In this course students undertake a detailed analysis of English phonology, morphology, and syntax. This course also involves topics such as the historical development of English and its contemporary status as the language of global communication.
